This is a full time position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Field Organizer is responsible for the implementation of the field program and is supervised by the Field Manager. The Field Organizer will also be responsible for managing his/her own team of volunteers.

Your primary responsibility as Field Organizer will be to recruit and mobilize volunteers on behalf of Michigan LCV in an effort to increase awareness and action on important environmental issues across the state.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Recruit, manage, and train volunteers.
- Identify and cultivate team leaders.
- Plan and execute events.
- Build relationships within communities.
- Work directly with the Field Manager to ensure that goals are met.
- Maintain the highest regard for data integrity.
- Other duties as assigned.

Necessary Qualifications:

The Field Organizer must have:

- Excellent writing skills, including the ability to take complex issues and communicate them to the general public;

- Three + years experience in field organizing, communications, campaigns or other related work;
- Excellent “people skills” and a track record of using them in prior capacities;
- Experience with project management, including both staff and consultants/vendors;
- Experience with on-line and traditional communications and advocacy;
- Solid computer skills, including familiarity with Microsoft Office and, ideally, website programs;
- Campaign experience, either electoral or issue-focused, preferable;
- Fine-tuned organizational skills and ability to work both independently and collaboratively;
- Ability to travel frequently throughout the county/region;
- A bachelor’s degree in a related field; and
- A general understanding of environmental issues and Michigan politics combined with a commitment to the mission and purpose of Michigan LCV and Michigan LCV Education Fund.

Benefits and Compensation
