This position reports to the Voting Rights Organizer and the Lead Canvassers and is responsible for the following:

- Attend daily education forums, creative sessions, and social debriefs
- Collect and report any challenges voters face
- Attend and engage in community events in Metro Detroit, Lansing, and Grand Rapids areas
- Communicate within communities about voting rights, government, and voting accessibility information

Qualifications

We are seeking candidates who want to build genuine relationships and support voter education and mobilization efforts in Michigan. You should have:

- The ability to work both from home and in person, as required, 35 hours per week, a flexible 12:00 - 7:00 PM Monday through Thursday and 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM on Fridays, with potential for commitments outside of those hours
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including a demonstrated ability to listen to others and articulate their ideas clearly
- The ability to work well independently and creatively with others as a team
- A strong, innovative work ethic, including a self-starting drive to complete goals and tasks in a timely manner as well as the ability to start work on time every day
- A belief in the importance of voting rights and voter education
- Reliable access to transportation, the internet, and a phone to use for work purposes
