This position reports to the Voting Rights Manager and the Lead Advocate and is responsible for the following:

- Attend online and in-person trainings on all educational outlets and technology platforms used by Michigan LCVEF's Democracy for All program
- Identify and attend high-traffic areas to register eligible Michiganders to vote and re-registered voters at their correct addresses
- Collect and submit voter registration cards
- Communicate within communities about voting rights, government, and voting accessibility information

We are seeking candidates who want to build genuine relationships and support voter registration, education, and mobilization efforts in Michigan. You should have:

- The ability to work in person, as required, a flexible 35 hours per week
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including a demonstrated ability to listen to others and articulate their ideas clearly

- A strong, innovative work ethic, including a self-starting drive to complete goals and tasks in a timely manner as well as the ability to start work on time every day
